Did everyone enjoy the show this year? As a first-ever Show Chair, I was grateful events unfolded as smoothly as they did, and have made note of a few lessons learned. Thank you to the many who pitched in to make set-up and clean up fun and easy! We were blessed with good weather – well, the sprinkles early in the day dampened a few things, but then it cleared up and was not unbearably hot for dogs and people.

The entry was down from last year, but near the average for the last several years. And our Obedience entry doubled over 2013! Given the expenses of the ring, judges, AKC fees and Superintendent, it is impossible to break even by the entry numbers alone. The auction and trophy sponsorship go a long way in making it viable for the club to put on a Specialty. This year we made a small profit, around \$500.



I am extremely grateful to the Show Committee – Jill Brennan, Sheila Wald and Katrina Sullivan – for the many hours they put in, going way back to the first of the year. Completing many pages of paperwork for AKC approval, contracting with the judges, lining up trophies and sponsorships, ordering ribbons, coordinating with BaRay, arranging for judges' lunches, proofing the Premium List, Judging Program and Catalog . . . and more. The club is fortunate to have these dedicated and knowledgeable folks!

Getting the RV parking arranged always seems a bit of a hassle, but Gail Fleming and Chuck Strong took on the challenge and got it taken care of nicely. How about those welcome bags?!

Impressive, thanks to Paula Craig. Judges gifts were put together and beautifully presented by Gale Shay. Then, the day of the show, up early to set up. I thought the judge's table looked so nice, with the many flowers in fun vases arranged and donated by Laurel Zepp from TEVCO.

Catalog sales were the responsibility of Tonya Gisselberg, and thanks to Gail and several others for stepping in during her absence. Tonya was one of the Obedience ring stewards, along with Teri Kaluza drafted by the English Cocker Club, with whom we shared a judge and ring. Katrina then volunteered to steward for the Cockers. The coordination between clubs went well and we will likely do that again next year.

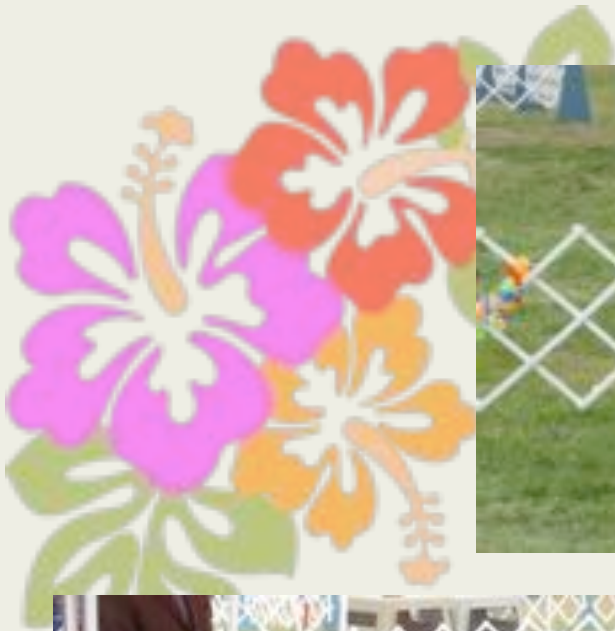

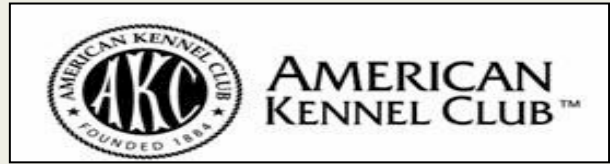






### *New Grand Championship Ranking System*

The American Kennel Club® (AKC®) recently introduced its newest conformation ranking system for dog show exhibitors and their dogs – the Grand Championship Ranking System. It launched with more than 1,000 dogs already ranked nationwide.



Located in the new Grand Championship section ([www.akc.org/grandchampionship/](http://www.akc.org/grandchampionship/)) of the AKC website, the Grand Championship Points Ranking ([www.akc.org/grand\\_championship/index.cfm?type=gc&section=lifetime](http://www.akc.org/grand_championship/index.cfm?type=gc&section=lifetime)) lists the top 25 dogs in each breed in a drop-down box format. The ranking is based on the number of Grand Championship points garnered at shows by achieving Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog or Select Bitch.

"We're pleased to provide this new ranking system for Grand Champions," said AKC Vice President Event Operations Robin Stansell. "We encourage owners to continue showing their Champions towards attaining a Grand Champion title and gain further recognition of quality."

The new point counting document ([www.akc.org/events/conformation/counting\\_grand\\_championship\\_points.cfm](http://www.akc.org/events/conformation/counting_grand_championship_points.cfm)) featured on the website will help fanciers count their dog's Grand Championship points. After initial completion of the Grand Championship, dogs will continue to earn points by winning Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Both breeds will be eligible to compete in their respective groups beginning July 2<sup>nd</sup> of this year.

To become an AKC recognized breed there must be a minimum number of dogs geographically distributed throughout the U.S., as well as an established breed club of responsible owners and breeders. 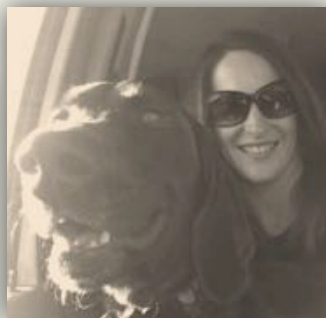
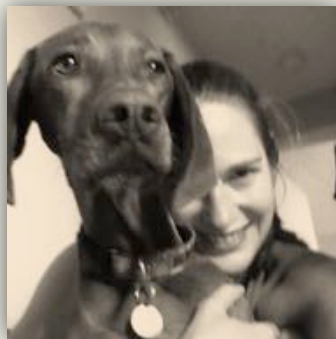
