Brock took 2nd in the Stud Dog competition with his daughters **Cedar** CH JASENI LE TIERAH'S TOTAL POWER TRIP (Nationals Winner's Bitch at 14 month old) and other daughter **Zona** SOKOLDALU'S B'ROCKIN HAUT HUNTRESS at 7 months old as well as qualifying in a couple agility runs!

In Redmond, OR Luna got a qualifying run in Novice Fast agility (and a 1st place), two qualifying runs in Coursing, and two qualifying runs in Barn Hunt (with a 3rd place on Saturday, and a beautiful 1st place today - she completed the hunt in 27 seconds!).

In April **Sola** Int'l CH Sokoldalu's Sunkissed Eyecandy by Tierah CGC took Winners both days in Ephrata, WA and in Ohio she took a very respectable 4th place both shows at the VCA Nationals and then took winners both day at the Puyallup show in June. Also in Redmond, OR she got one qualifying run in Barn Hunt and two qualifying runs in Lure Coursing (handled by Gaelyn Krauser).

In February at her first weekend out showing **Zona** Sokoldalu's B'Rockin Haut Huntress takes Best Puppy at the TEVCO's 4-6 month puppy competition and then in her second outing all the way to Ohio at 7 month, she took 4th place in her puppy class at VCA Nationals. She is owned by Rosemary Hodges and Tony Johnston and Carla Slabaugh.


