# AKC Breeder Education Expands Content With New Courses

The American Kennel Club (AKC®) continues to expand the educational content available to breeders via our online learning platform, AKC Canine College.

The most recent course additions to Canine College round out content provided by famed dog author and breeding expert Claudia Waller Orlandi, Ph.D. Breeders will now have access to detailed courses on anatomy, kennel blindness, and genetic defects.

The ABC's of Dog Breeding – Anatomy, Part 1 provides breeders with knowledge of the anatomy of the standing dog. The course covers overall structural balance and correctness, but also breaks down the evaluation of a dog's correctness into smaller, more tangible anatomical parts. These features include size, substance, stance, and key proportions. This approach helps create templates that can be applied to numerous breeds.

- The ABC's of Dog Breeding Anatomy, Part 2 focuses on the anatomy of the dog in motion. The course's approach to evaluating movement is similar to learning the individual parts of the standing dog because there are also tangible, measurable features that can be used as templates to evaluate good, as well as faulty, movement.
- The phenomenon known as kennel blindness, which is a breeder's inability or unwillingness to admit to the failings or faults in
  his or her own dogs, is discussed in The ABC's of Dog Breeding Kennel Blindness. Because serious faults can be fixed in a
  couple of generations unless they are not quickly diagnosed and treated, kennel blindness is powerful enough to destroy the
  success of a breeding program.

For breeder insight into techniques that can be used to assess the risk of producing genetic disease when planning a mating, check out **The ABC's of Dog Breeding – Genetic Defects**. The elimination of genetic defects from a breeding program should be the highest priority and requires doing a lot of homework on the ancestors in pedigrees.

Canine College is a great way for AKC Bred with H.E.A.R.T. members to meet the annual education requirement. These educational courses are available to breeders at no cost. Breeders may opt to be tested on the material and receive a certificate upon passing the examinations for a nominal fee.

With the support of Royal Canin U.S.A., Inc. as the sponsor of breeder education, the AKC continues its long-standing commitment to advance the health and welfare of all dogs by creating one of the world's foremost online breeder education libraries.



Dogs, like people, can be afflicted with stomach problems, including indigestion, <u>diarrhea</u>, and <u>gas</u>. Although severe or prolonged symptoms should always be treated by a veterinarian, minor cases of stomach upset or diarrhea can be cared for at home with "people" medications that are safe for dogs. If symptoms persist or if you've never given a food or medication mentioned below to your dog, call your veterinarian.

# OTC MEDICATIONS SAFE FOR TREATING GI AND STOMACH PROBLEMS IN DOGS

<u>Pepto-Bismol</u> (bismuth subsalicylate) is safe to offer most dogs, but AKC's Chief Veterinary Officer Dr. Jerry Klein says he rarely recommends it because the salicylates in the medication could cause gastric bleeding, and the bismuth in the medication can turn the stool black, which may mask any resulting gastric bleeding. "If it must be given, offer no more than one or two doses after consulting with your veterinarian," he says. Your veterinarian may instead recommend the bismuth subsalicylate product formulated for dogs, called Corrective Suspension. Dogs with bleeding disorders and dogs who are <u>pregnant or nursing</u> should not take any form of bismuth subsalicylate, nor should dogs taking non-steroidal anti-inflammatory agents such as <u>Rimadyl</u> and Deramaxx. **Cats** 

should never be given bismuth subsalicylate, as it is toxic to them.

Pepto-Bismol Dosage For Dogs: The recommended dosage is 1 teaspoon for every 10 pounds, according to Dr. Klein. It can be offered to the dog every 6-to-8 hours, but if your dog still has diarrhea after a few doses, stop the medication and call your veterinarian. Also, if you've never given Pepto-Bismol to your dog before, check with your veterinarian to confirm the dosage.

How to administer Pepto-Bismol to Dogs: Use an empty (no needle) plastic syringe to give your dog the medication. Open his mouth, place the empty syringe toward the back of the tongue and push the plunger, then hold his muzzle for a second to ensure he swallows it.



<u>Imodium</u> (loperamide) is another over-the-counter medication dogs can take, which also helps resolve diarrhea. Dogs with certain conditions and dogs taking certain medications should not be given Imodium, so check with your veterinarian before administering it. Cats may have a reaction to this medication—ask for veterinary guidance before offering it to a feline.

• Imodium Dosage For Dogs: A dog can take one 2-milligram pill per 40 pounds of body weight two-to-three times a day, says Dr. Klein. Call your veterinarian first to verify dosage. Do not offer this medication for more than two days. If symptoms persist, seek veterinary care.

How to administer Imodium to Dogs: Give the tablet to your dog in a pill pocket (the <u>Greenies™</u> brand is recommended) or wrapped in a bit of food (like cheese). Use only enough food to hide the taste of the pill or you may risk further irritating your dog's stomach.

Pepto-Bismol Safe for Dogs (Along with Other OTC Medications)?

<u>Pepcid</u> (famotidine): If your pet has issues with stomach acid build-up, gastric ulcers, or other stomach- or GI-related issues, many veterinarians recommend this. Although this medication has not been FDA-approved for use in pets, it's considered standard practice for veterinarians to recommend its use in certain dogs and cats. Contact your veterinarian before administering—it may not be recommended if your pet is pregnant or nursing or has a medical condition.

• Pepcid Dosage for Dogs: For both dogs and cats, the dosage is one 10-milligram tablet for a 20-pound dog every 12-to-24 hours, says Dr. Klein. It is best to give this medication one hour before meals. Check with a veterinarian to verify the dosage is accurate for your pet. Also, if purchasing Pepcid, make sure to buy Pepcid Original Strength (10 milligram tablets). Pepcid Complete contains additional active ingredients, and Pepcid Maximum Strength contains more medication per tablet.

**How to Administer Pepcid to Dogs:** It's not recommended to give Pepcid with food, as it can lessen its efficacy. Instead tilt your dog's head back, place the pill on the back of the tongue, hold the mouth shut for a moment, and gently stroke the throat or blow on the nose to induce swallowing. If you do not have experience giving pills to your dog without a treat, contact your veterinarian for advice.

Certain foods, such as pumpkin and rice, can also help with stomach issues in dogs. Learn more about that here.

Dr. Klein says he's also prescribed probiotics to treat diarrhea, such as Pro-Viable or Fortiflora. "If diarrhea is not severe, results are noticed within 24 hours," he says. Consult with your veterinarian about acquiring similar products.



For starters, when you make your own dog treats, you have control over what ingredients are included. Want another reason to make these vet-approved dog treats? The recipes are quick, easy, and fun!

# APPLE PRETZELS RECIPE FOR DOGS

The recipe may look like it has a lot of steps, but this 3-ingredient baked treat is easy to make. And, if you've ever made pretzels, you know they're fun to roll and twist. You can even make your own crazy shapes. Your dog won't care how you twist them — he'll love the taste.

#### Ingredients

- 3 cups almond flour
- 1 egg
- 1 cup plain, unsweetened applesauce

#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit
- 2. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper and set aside
- 3. Beat egg and set aside
- 4. Mix applesauce and almond flour in a large bowl
- 5. Pour 1 tablespoon of the egg into a bowl and set aside
- 6. Pour the rest of the egg into the bowl with mixed ingredients
- 7. Stir the mixture until a dough forms
- 8. Take a two-tablespoon-size piece of dough and roll into a tube
- 9. Take each tube and make into a "U" shape, then twist the ends together and fold back to the top to make a pretzel shape
- 10. Place the pretzels onto the baking tray
- 11. Brush the top of each pretzel with the remaining egg
- 12. Bake for approximately 25-30 minutes, until they're slightly browned and firm
- 13. Remove from the oven and allow to cool before serving

#### **Ingredients**

- 4 cups almond flour
- ¾ cup flax meal
- ½ cup blackberries
- 1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil
- 1 egg

**Directions** (Blackberry Biscuit Dog Treats Recipe)

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper
- 3. Mix all ingredients together with
- 1 cup water to form a dough
- 4. Roll dough until 1/4-inch thick
- 5. Cut out biscuits with small cookie cutter
- 6. Re-roll remaining dough and cut out more biscuits
- 7. Place biscuits 1 inch apart on prepared baking sheet
- 8. Bake for 30 minutes, until nicely browned and firm
- 9. Remove biscuits from oven and allow to cool before serving

# MINI OMELETTE RECIPE FOR DOGS

What, you may ask, makes this omelette different from one you'd make for yourself? Maybe only the absence of spices, herbs, and butter. Your dog won't miss that stuff — he'll love this healthy treat. He'll be so busy gobbling it down that he won't mind if you make one for yourself.

### Ingredients

• 2 eggs

Eggs are a great source of protein and can help an upset stomach. However, eating raw egg whites can give dogs biotin deficiency, so be sure to cook the eggs all the way through before giving them to your pet.

• ½ cup cooked salmon, thinly sliced, OR pulled grilled chicken

Salmon is loaded with vitamins and protein.

Make sure chicken is skinless and boneless.

• ½ green pepper, diced

Bell peppers provide beta-carotene and are high in vitamin C.

#### **Directions**

- 1. Lightly grease frying pan with a small drizzle of extra virgin olive oil
- 2. Turn the heat for the frying pan to medium/high
- 3. Crack eggs into a bowl and stir with fork until mixed
- 4. Once the frying pan is heated, gently pour the mixed eggs into the center of the frying pan
- 5. Tilt the pan to spread the egg mixture evenly
- 6. Once the egg is halfway firm, sprinkle on the green pepper and salmon or grilled chicken
- 7. With a spatula, fold the egg in half and allow to heat until egg appears to be firm
- 8. Remove omelet from pan and place on plate
- 9. Allow to cool and serve

# FROZEN MEAT TREATS RECIPE FOR DOGS

Chicken and <u>carrots</u> are two of dogs' favorite foods. This vet-approved frozen meat treat adds another — a little yogurt. Freeze the treats in ice cube trays, and you'll have a ready-made treat for your dog anytime.

#### Ingredients

• 2 cups grilled chicken

Make sure chicken is skinless and boneless.

• ¾ plain low-fat or fat-free yogurt

Do not use yogurt with xylitol, and do not use at all if dog is lactose intolerant.

• 1 carrot

If your <u>dog is diabetic</u>, use a smaller amount.

• 3 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil

#### **Directions**

- 1. Stir all the ingredients together
- 2. Freeze in ice cube trays
- 3. For small dogs, you can pour the mixture into a piping bag and pipe little droplets onto a parchment-lined baking sheet before freezing

Made with fresh berries, these patriotic popsicles can be a Fourth of July treat for your dog. And they'll be just as good on any hot day. As a plus, they're quick and easy to make.

#### **Ingredients**

• 1 cup whole blueberries

Blueberries are high in fiber, antioxidants, and phytochemicals.

• 1/2 cup chopped strawberries

Strawberries are high in sugar. Use small amounts if your dog is diabetic.

• 1 cup plain yogurt

Do not use yogurt containing xylitol. Do not use if your dog is lactose intolerant.

#### Directions

- 1. Gently mix all ingredients together in a bowl
- 2. Pour mixture into ice cube tray or large mold
- 3. Freeze for at least 4-to-5 hours
- 4. Remove one popsicle, and let your dog enjoy!
