Crunchy Baked Parmesan Pheasant

Homemade spices plus a crunchy crust make this baked Parmesan pheasant recipe to die for

Ingredients:

- 1/4 cup butter
- 2 ½ pounds pheasant
- 1 egg
- 2 tablespoons milk
- 1/2 teaspoon homemade garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon homemade onion powder
- 1 cup instant potato buds
- 1/2 cup parmesan cheese, grated
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

Directions:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Melt 1/4 cup butter and place in flat casserole dish.

Wash and dry the pheasant. Whisk the egg, garlic powder, onion powder and milk together in one bowl. Mix potato flakes and cheese in another bowl.

Dip pheasant pieces in the milk mixture, then roll in the flakes to coat. Place skin-side down in the baking dish. Sprinkle with salt and pepper.

Bake uncovered for 30 minutes. Turn pieces, sprinkle again with salt, pepper and the remaining potato flake/cheese mixture. Bake another 30 minutes.



DIY Dog Treats: Pumpkin Sweet Potato Bites

These gluten-free treats are made with (full recipe below):

Brown Rice Flour – This gluten-free flour is simply ground up grain brown rice. Adding it to your dog biscuits will give them a mild nutty flavor, which compliments the other ingredients in this treat.

Sweet Potato – Sweet potatoes provide a nice serving of fiber, key vitamins, and various minerals. When feeding them to your dog, make sure they're unseasoned (or seasoned with dog-approved spices/herbs), peeled, cooked, and mashed.

100% Pure Pumpkin Purée – Pumpkin is considered a superfood for our canine cuties. It's loaded with fiber, making it great for digestion and weight management. Plus, pumpkin also contains potassium and a moderate amount of protein. *This isn't to be confused with pumpkin pie filling, which contains sugar and spices that aren't good for dogs.



Yields 127

Ingredients

- 1½ Cups Brown Rice Flour
- ½ Teaspoon Cinnamon
- 1 Cup Mashed Sweet Potato
- ½ Cup 100% Pure Pumpkin Purée
- ½ Cup Water
- 1 Egg
- 1 Teaspoon Organic Maple Syrup

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350°F.

Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper. Set aside.

In a large mixing bowl, whisk together brown rice flour and cinnamon.

In a separate bowl, mash sweet potato.

Add pumpkin, water, egg, and maple syrup to sweet potato and mix until thoroughly combined.

Add wet ingredients to dry ingredients and mix together with a spoon until you're left with a thick batter.

With your fingers, pinch off a small amount of the mixture (approx. 3/4 teaspoon) and roll into little balls. Place the balls on the baking sheet, spacing them about an inch apart.

After treats are placed on the baking sheet, take a fork and flatten the little balls to around a ¼" thick.

Bake at 350°F for 20 minutes.

*Flip them over and continue baking another 10 minutes.

Transfer to a wire rack to cool.

Notes

Store in refrigerator for up to a week in an airtight container and in freezer for up to a month.

For crispier Pumpkin Sweet Potato Waffle Fries, continue baking until desired consistency.



How to Make a Square Knot Dog Tug Toy

You'll need:

- Fleece fabric, or other slightly stretchy material like t-shirt fabric
- Scissors

Fabric ruler or other way to measure the fabric





Here's how:

- 1. Cut 4 lengths of fleece fabric. About 2" wide and 45" long is ideal for a medium-sized dog.
- 2. Tie a regular overhand knot at one end, leaving a few inches of fabric as a tail. Pull the knot tight.
- 3. Tie your square knots:
- 4. Open your 4 strips into a plus sign shape.
 - * Fold the top strip towards the bottom, a little to one side, always the same side as you progress.
 - * Fold the bottom strip towards the top, a little to the other side, always the same side as you progress.
 - * Fold the right strip towards the left. Pass over the first strip, then under the second.
 - * Fold the left strip toward the right. Pass over the first strip, then under the second.
 - Pull all of the strips nice and tight.
- 5. When you've got about 5 inches left, tie off the end with another overhand knot and pull tightly
- 6. Trim off tails to make them even.
- 7. Split each of the tails in two to make the ends a little more festive.

Smile a knowing smile that you are a dog-toy making genius.
