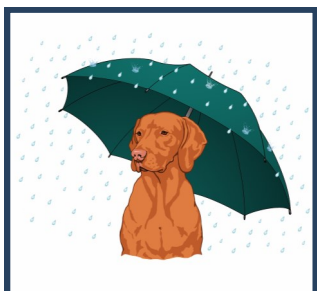

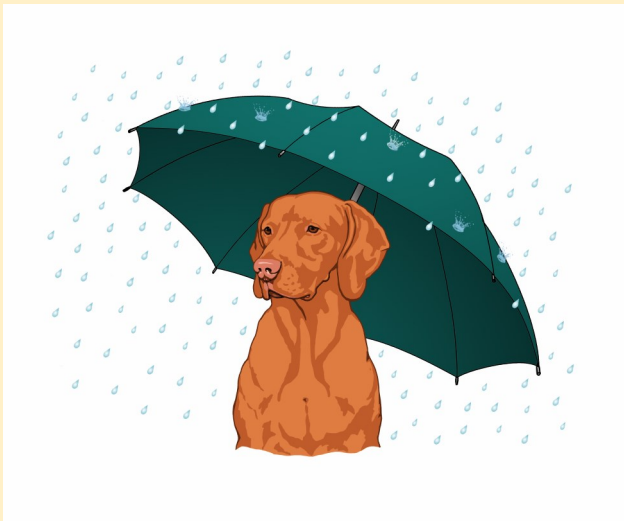

Winter Tips for you Vizsla

BE STORM PREPARED

Create a Disaster Kit with food, water, and medication that can last 5 days.

PAW PATROL

Check regularly for damage & cracked paws and wash/wipe away salt after outdoor walks

OUTERWEAR WEATHER

Keep them warm with coats and sweaters. If they are not panting when they are exercising, they are too cold

ANTIFREEZE!

Watch for spills and leaks. The sweet taste of the extremely poisonous antifreeze is very attractive to pets.

HOLIDAY PLANTS

Some plants like poinsettias and mistletoes are toxic to dogs.

DECORATIONS

Ribbons and tinsel and similar decorations can cause a surgical emergency if ingested.

FROZEN WATER HAZARDS

Avoid frozen water hazards. Dogs can fall through thin ice and suffer hypothermia or even drown.

TRIM THOSE NAILS!

It is difficult for pets to maintain solid footing with long nails in icy conditions.

FROST BITE

Ears and toes are susceptible to frost bite, so limit time outside.

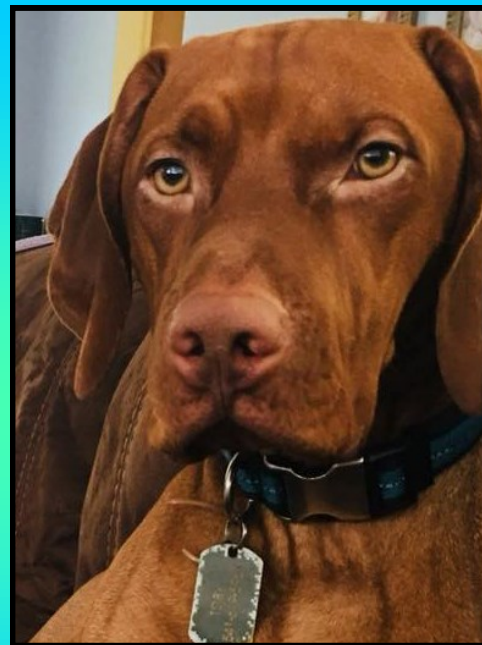
