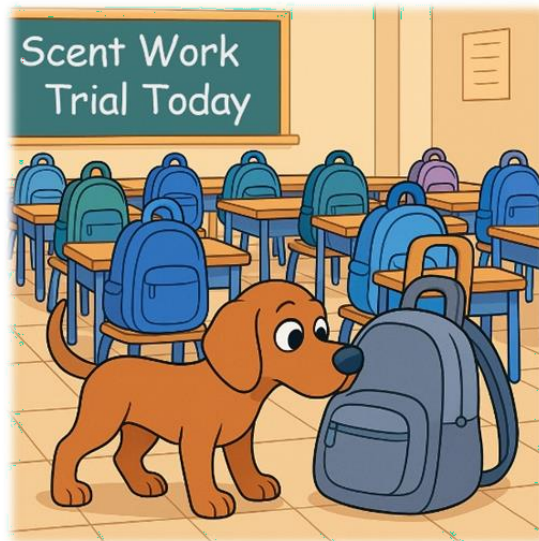

Novice A/B Classes

Novice A classes are open to dogs who have not completed any title for that particular element, who have not completed a comparable title with another organization, and whose handlers are neither Scent Work judges, nor have ever worked as professional detection dog handlers.

Handler Discrimination Division

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handler themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag, for the Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock, for Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs. Three qualifying scores are required to earn titles in each class.

Transfers (up and down) in accordance with the regulations will be offered between trials as long as judge limits are not exceeded. The committee requests that all transfer request forms be turned in within 30 minutes of the last run of the day. A transfer form must be completed for each event entered.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

WAIT LIST/REFUND INFORMATION

Puget Sound Vizsla Club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time for Detective. A maximum of **5 Detectives/day** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 5PM PDT **May 25, 2026**. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on May 25, 2026. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a refund. Withdrawals for females in season after the closing date must be received one-half hour before the start of the first class of the day of the trial to be refunded. **For refunds pertaining to the waitlist, pulled entries, or bitches in season, please know that if you entered online, the fees you paid to enter online will not be refunded, just the entry fee.**

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Areas will be provided out of view of search area(s).

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class or on the line at the judge's discretion. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if handlers have the option of running off-leash, the number of hides (if known), maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the group Handler's Briefing.

Warm-up area One labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Blank containers in the warm-up area may be present.

Check-in and Information Run orders, results and ribbons will be provided at the trial information table.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class. These trials will be held at various locations at the Elementary School.

Search Area Conditions. Searches may be indoors on matted, carpeted, concrete or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, dirt, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. Search area sizes will be in accordance with the AKC Scent Work Regulations.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Scents. No person other than those engaged in the administration of the trial shall be in possession of any of the target odors when on the trial grounds.

Spectator Area. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

Indoor Crating Space will be available for well-behaved dogs in the school commons. Crates may be left overnight; however, the **Puget Sound Vizsla Club** and the **Northwood Middle School** will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Do not use flowerbeds or landscaped areas for pottying dogs. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run. Rosettes will be awarded for each qualifying Detective run.

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue
Second Place	Red
Third Place	Yellow
Fourth Place	White
Qualifying Score	Dark Green

New Element and New Level title rosettes will be available. Special Overall Master Level Rosette and Detective title rosettes will also be available. All ribbons and rosettes must be picked up at the trial; they will not be mailed.

High in Trial will not be offered or awarded.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

Dog safety is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Puget Sound Vizsla Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Puget Sound Vizsla Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against The Puget Sound Vizsla Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except as described herein. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge. Detective may be run off-leash.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical conditions are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: Check-in information will be provided in the secretary's final confirmation emails prior to the trial.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Washington state requires dogs to be vaccinated for rabies.
